

## **College Scholarship Award Requirements**

Florida Repertory Theatre's Education Department is committed to supporting and enriching the experiences of young artists. This scholarship will be awarded to one freshman undergraduate student who will be majoring in theatre arts in order to assist them with their artistic aspirations.

The Florida Repertory Theatre Scholarship is a \$500.00 award geared to helping support a graduating high school senior on their career path to a degree in theatre arts.

Requirements and Guidelines for this scholarship are as follows:

- Must have 3.0 overall GPA in high school.
- Must be a graduating senior in High School going into their first year of college.
- Must have participated in at least one Florida Rep Education class, camp or conservatory production.
- Must be pursuing a BA or BFA degree in Theatre Arts (Performing or Technical Theatre)
- Must send resume with theatrical experience included.
- Must send a one to two page essay addressing the following questions;
  - How would this scholarship benefit you on your career path in theatre arts?
  - Why have you selected theatre as a potential career?
  - What are your college and career goals for the next five years?
- Must submit <u>two</u> Letters of Reference detailing why you would be the best applicant for the Florida Repertory Theatre Scholarship Award.
  - One of the two letters must be from someone who has supervised you in a production or theatre class.
- Please note: If an application is incomplete or does not follow the above criteria it will not be considered valid.

- Application deadline is March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Applications will not be considered after this date and recipients will be announced by April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
